## Compulsory Vaccines

Guidelines from the French Department of Health, related to internships in physiotherapy, are as follows:

- Besides vaccination against Diphtheria, Tetanus and Poliomyelitis (unique injection DTPolio), students must be immunized against Tuberculosis.
- Concerning this disease, students must have received an intradermal tuberculin test (recently performed). The result of this test must be communicated to the CEERRF.

In addition to that, students must be vaccinated against HEPATITIS B. The vaccination guidelines are as follows:

- First injection of the vaccine at least four months before the beginning of the internship.
- Second injection, one month later.
- Third injection, one month later again.
- A checking serology one month again.
- The result of this checking serology must be communicated to the CEERRF.

Therefore, a total time of a minimum of 4 months.

We raise awareness on the fact that without the checking serology result or if this result is negative, i.e., lower than 10 UI/l, the student could not perform the internship intended.


