

Charter of Eco-Responsible Training Organisations



Human health is influenced by many determinants, among which environmental determinants play a key role. Air quality, water quality, pollution, access to water and food, and living environment are all elements indispensable to humans for living in good health.

Rigorous scientific work over recent decades — the IPCC on climate, IPBES on biodiversity — warns us: current human activities are degrading these crucial elements for our health, and more broadly endangering the conditions for life on Earth.

Given the methodological quality and the volume of scientific work carried out, there is no room for doubt, nor for downplaying the gravity of the situation.

In light of these findings, it is essential that all stakeholders in our societies mobilise. Training organisations are part of this.

While aware of the need for ambitious political decisions, we recognise that it is within our power to do our part to reduce our environmental impact. We wish to act on the various dimensions of carbon impact, pollution, and the responsible use of resources.

Therefore, we have decided to act by signing the charter of eco-responsible training organisations established by the association Les Écokinés.

This is the first step in a set of measures we intend to implement in an authentic and determined manner.

As a training organisation, we therefore commit to:

- Carrying out an annual carbon assessment of all our training activities and communicating it publicly
- Communicating annually on the actions implemented to reduce our ecological footprint
- Facilitating and encouraging the use of low-carbon transport by students, staff, and instructors
- Prioritising plant-based food at festive events accompanying conferences, debates, and themed evenings
- Pursuing a “zero waste” objective in the daily operations of the initial training organisation and ensuring efficient waste sorting
- Being as energy-efficient as possible
- Raising awareness among our teaching and administrative teams, instructors, and students about climate issues and environmental health
- Promoting local actions linked to social ecology
- Integrating and promoting eco-responsibility in health within our teaching content
